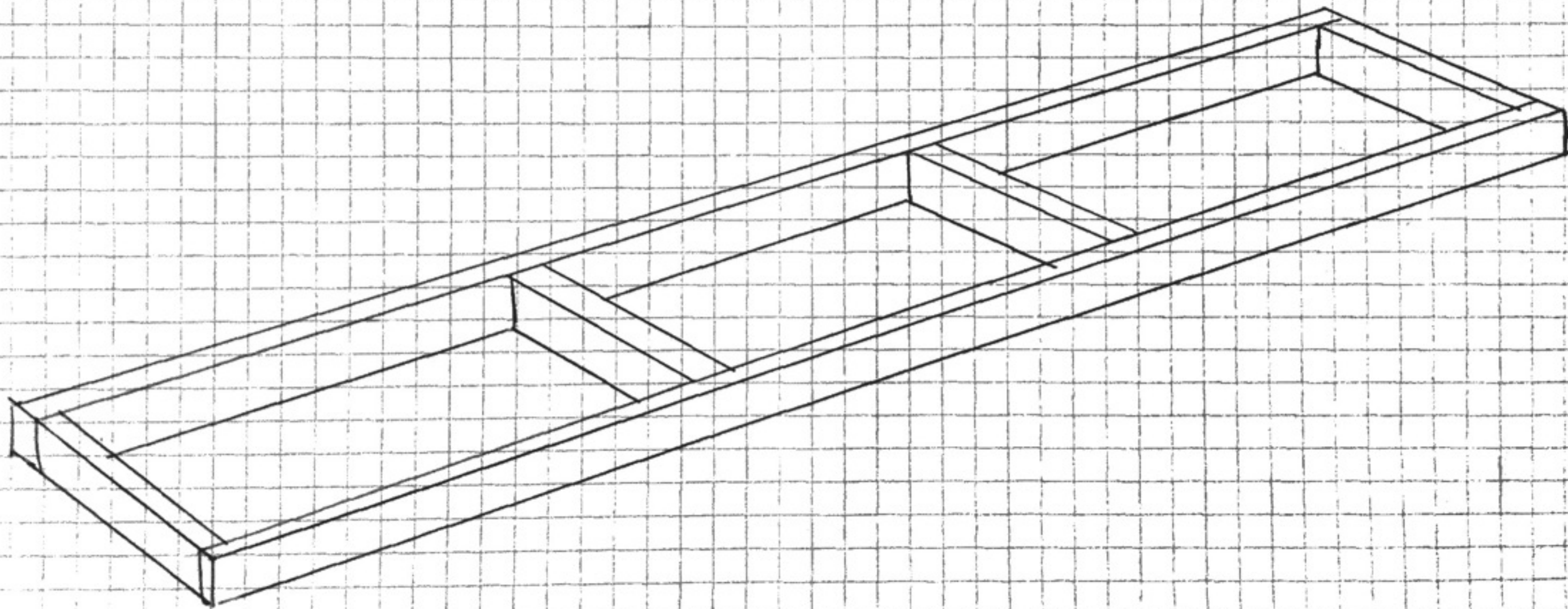


How to build a dipsy doodle.

Step One:

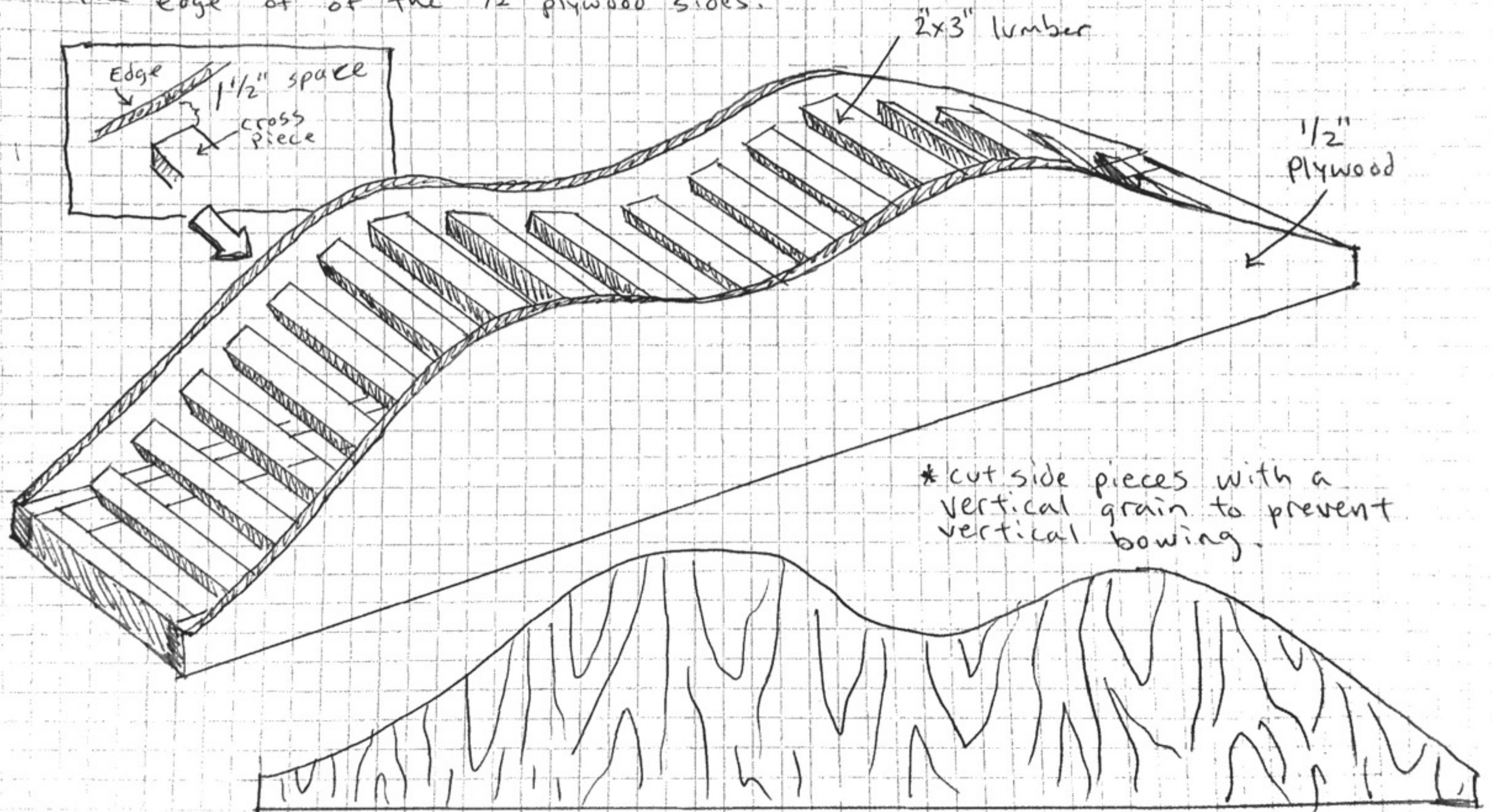
- Build out your base with 2"x3" framing lumber.
- You will only need a few cross pieces.



How to build a dipsy doodle.

Step Two:

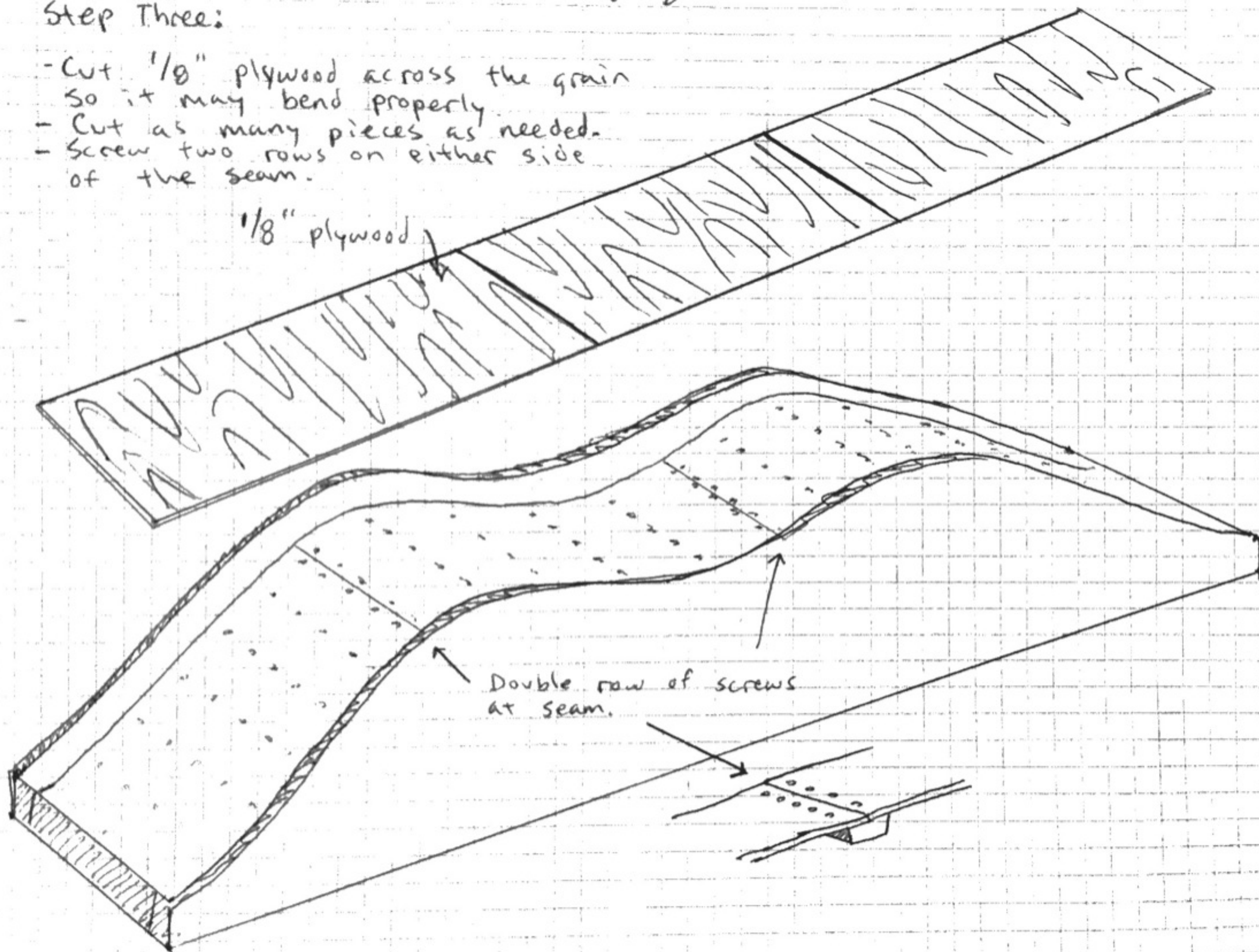
- Cut $\frac{1}{2}$ " plywood for sides. Screw them in at the base.
- Attach 2×3 " cross pieces spaced 2"-3" apart.
- Leave $1\frac{1}{2}$ " space between the cross piece and the edge of of the $\frac{1}{2}$ " plywood sides.



How to build a dipsy doodle.

Step Three:

- Cut $\frac{1}{8}$ " plywood across the grain so it may bend properly.
- Cut as many pieces as needed.
- Screw two rows on either side of the seam.



How to build a dippy doodle.

Step Four:

- Add a 2' to 3' lead up putting area.
- Attach this to the dippy doodle.
- Use 2" x 3" lumber for cross pieces topped with 1/2" plywood cut lengthwise with the grain to prevent dips between the cross pieces.
- Space cross-pieces 6" apart.
